Our 501(c)(3) nonprofit is purchasing and protecting land in western Maine to create the first ever conservation park that promotes human activities of hunting, foraging, fishing, wildcrafting, and recreating.

The targeted forestland of more than 4,000 contiguous acres is a wildlife corridor and home to moose, black bear, bobcat, humans, and many other species.

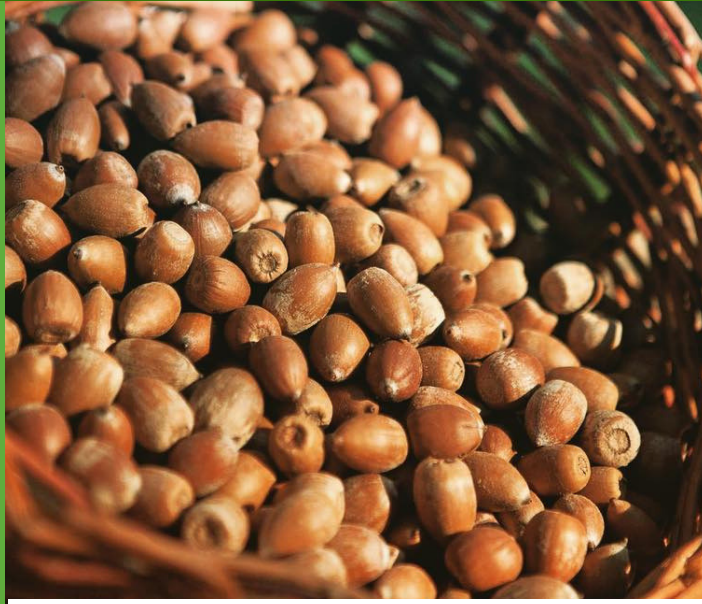

LAND

The protected area will be secured for wildlife habitat, public benefit, and as a hub for people to reconnect to the natural world and re-learn hunter-gatherer life ways.

EDUCATION

Preventing humans from interacting with the wild alienates them from nature, leading to apathy for protecting open spaces. We teach people how and why to relate to the natural world.

WATER

Childs Brook, located at Wilder Waters, is a pristine tributary of the Androscoggin River. We will protect this brook and advocate for the return of the Androscoggin as a clean source of wild food.

CONSERVATION

Our hands-on conservation method, called reciprocal conservation, views people as part of nature and calls for humans to become immersed in the ecology of place.
